Children's Advocacy Center Needs

- Clothes and shoes (of all sizes) to give to needy children after medical exams
- Pre-packaged snacks, juice boxes, small water bottles
- Medium children's white t-shirts for t-shirt project at the end of therapy
- Puff paints; art supplies
- Journals
- Any games (unopened preferably) for family game night
- Stress balls
- Gift cards to purchase birthday or graduation from therapy supplies for kids
- Bus passes
- New video equipment/surveillance system in the forensic interview room
- Laptop/Tablet for medical exam room
- Infant clothing - 0-24 months
- Baby bibs
- Strollers for clients who walk with their babies
- Sippy cups
- Lice treatment
- Diapers, wipes, diaper rash cream, sanitary sprays/wipes
- "Baby Length Measurement Mat" for medical exam room - much more accurate, particularly for Failure to Thrive infants.

Below are items that families who live paycheck to paycheck have a difficult time buying as food stamps do not cover these necessary items.

- Cleaning supplies such as:
 - Laundry soap
 - Floor cleaning stuff like Mr. Clean
 - Window cleaner
 - Toilet bowl cleaner
 - Bathroom cleaner
 - Lysol wipes
 - Kitchen cleaner
- Personal items:
 - Shampoo, Conditioner
 - Deodorant
 - Soap or body wash
 - Shavers and shaving cream
 - Perfume or body sprays
- Baby items:
 - Diapers (all sizes)
 - Baby wipes
 - Diaper cream
